Denison FFA Chapter Wins 2007 Iowa FFA Nursery/Landscape Development Event

The Denison FFA Chapter from Denison was named the Champion Team in the annual Iowa FFA Nursery/Landscape Career Development Event held at Des Moines Area Community College on the Ankeny Campus, June 14, 2007. The event consisted of a general knowledge exam, landscape drawing, problem solving, plant identification, plant judging, plant disorder identification, and situation assessment and solution. The Nursery/Landscape Career Development Event was coordinated and conducted by Tim Doud and Neil Van Veen and staff with the Agriculture Department at Des Moines Area Community College
